SBSI ACTIVITY REPORT

(15/07/2018 - 31/07/2018)

1. <u>Hospital Wall Painting (15/07/18 – 18/07/18)</u>

The SBSI activities were started from Puthukkad Taluk Hospital and Mattathoor Health Center. The buildings were painted by the SBSI volunteers in 4 days. The first two days were spent at Puthukkad Taluk Hospital and next two days were at Mattathoor Health Centre. Four buildings including walls and window grills were painted during this activity. From this activity an asset of 1 lakh rupees was created.



2. Premises cleaning at Kodakara Health Center (20/07/18-23/07/18)

The SBSI volunteers cleaned the surroundings of Kodakara Health centre. Volunteers worked for 4 days for cleaning the 60 cent of land and setting up the plantation in the cleaned land. Medicinal plants and tapioca were planted on cleared area. The hospital staffs were highly supportive towards this activity.



3. Rally (26/07/18)

The SBSI volunteers organized an awareness rally at Kodakara town in association with Sahrdaya College of Engg. & Tech, sensitizing the public about the harmful effects of the plastic waste. The first-year students consisting of more than 400 students and 18 teachers participated in the Swachhta Rally. Students were provided with pluck-cards and slogans against plastic use were announced throughout the rally. The pre-preparations were made on the previous days by SBSI volunteers by creating pluck cards for more than 400 students.





4. Waste collection Drives and Segregation of solid waste (26/07/18)

Groups of 20 students along with a teacher were given big waste collection bags to collect the waste. Students collected more than 60 bags of waste from houses, shops and the roadsides. After the program, the waste was collected back to the school where the plastic waste and paper waste were segregated and given to Apollo tyres.

Conditional Survey Report on Flood Affected Area 30/08/2018 to 01/09/2018

CONDITIONAL SURVEY REPORT IN FLOOD AFFECTED AREAS

From August 30-September 1, we the students of Sahrdaya College of Engineering and Technology conducted a Rapid Visual Screening of Buildings & Conditional survey in flood related areas. The survey was conducted in the houses of 3 Panchayats namely, Aloor, Parappookkara and Kodakara.

We have covered 2500 houses in Parappookkara Panchayat, 1650 houses in Aloor Panchayat and 900 houses in Kodakara Panchayat. 400 students and 100 faculties (teaching and non-teaching staffs) participated in the survey.

We submitted the documents and photographs related to the survey to the respective panchayats.





Cleaning at St. James nursing Academy, Chalakudy:

On August 24 & 25th, we students of Sahrdaya College of Engineering and Technology participated in the cleaning process related to the flood relief program. 75 students and 2 faculties participated in this cleaning.





Repairing of motor pump sets:

Students of college repaired the motor set at free cost which has been damaged during flood days.





Contaminated water testing:

Samples of water collected from water resources in the flood areas including public places and different houses and tested. After testing, the amount of contamination of water was found precisely and also gave the instruction to purify the water

House cleaning:

During the rehabilitation days, many students of our college actively participated in the cleaning process of 15 houses including houses of faculty members of our college.

Donation of money to chief minister's flood relief fund:

The students, teachers, non-teaching staffs and management collectively contributed an amount of Rs.10, 00,000 (Ten Lakhs) to the chief minister's flood relief fund. In the presence of principal, executive director, student representative, hand over the cheque to the education minister Shri.C. Ravindranath.
