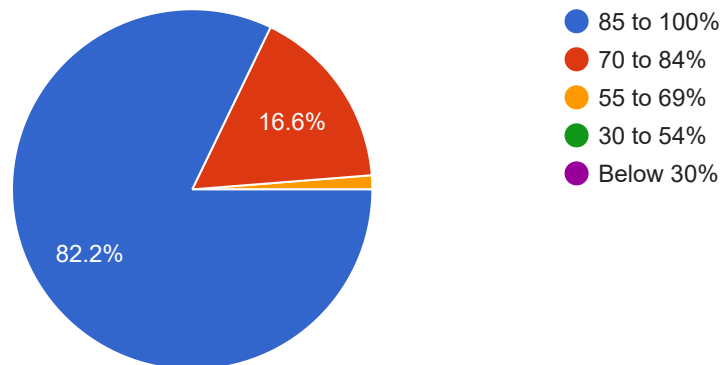

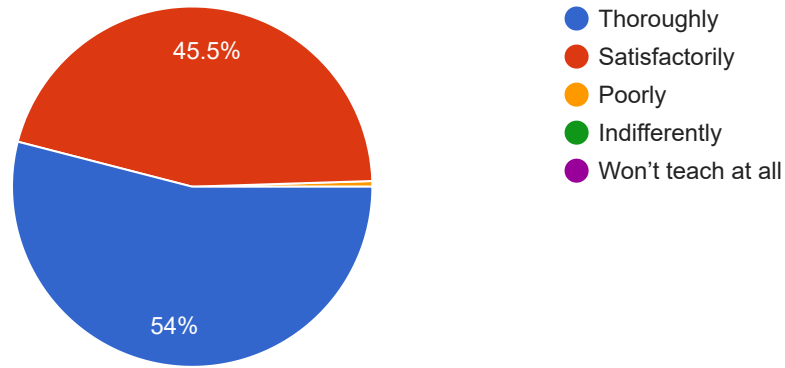

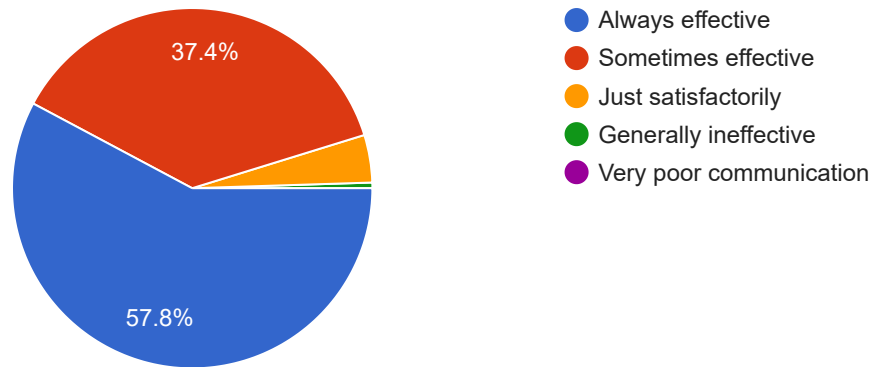

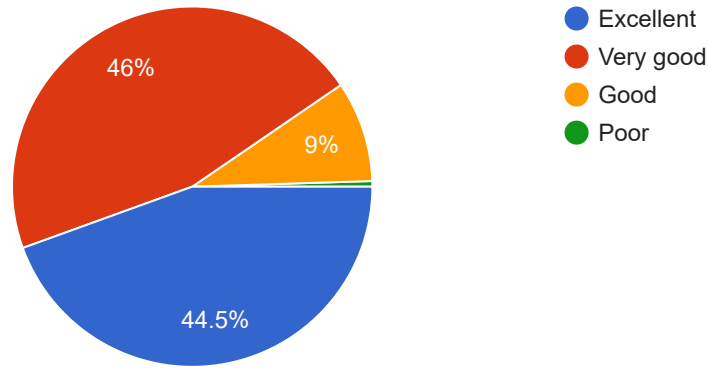

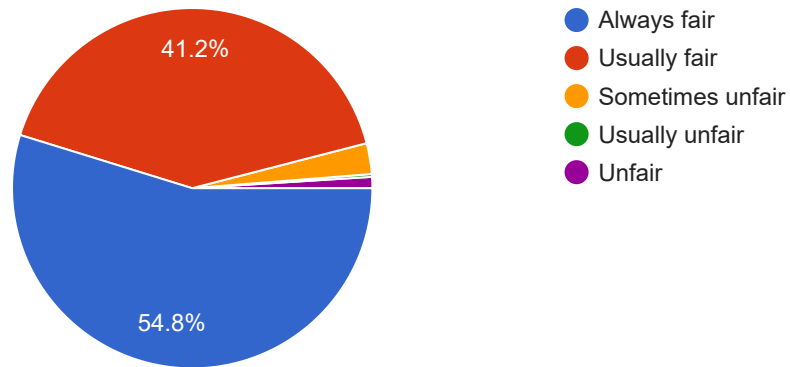

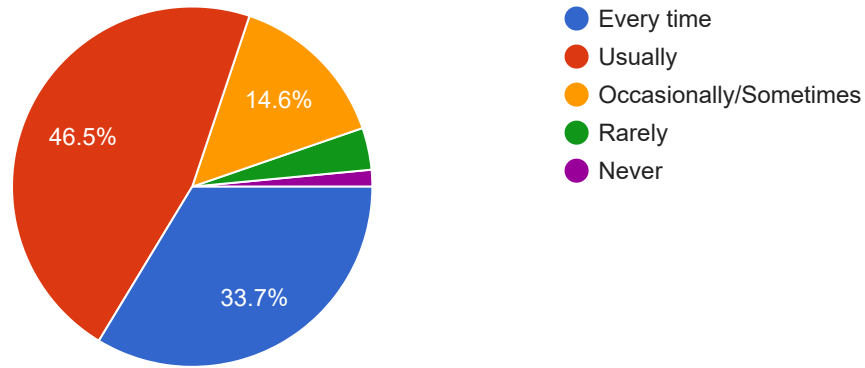

2. Don't treat the students like children. They are not. The students attending the college are adults. Certain 'disciplinary' activities, such as mandating class attendance, having morning assemblies, being 'strict' on students, etc do not help in creating a welcoming and flexible environment for the students, which is essential for their development.
3. The dynamics between the students and the management need a drastic upheaval. The current management seems to not care for the opinion of the students at all.
