ORDER

The University Grants Commission constituted under the University Grants Commission Act, 1956, (Central Act No.3 of 1956) vide letters read (1) to (4) above have informed the University that the competent authority of the UGC has decided to grant autonomous status to Vimal Jyothi Engineering College and St. Joseph's College of Engineering and Technology, Palai for a period of 5 years from 2024-2025 to 2028-2029 and Sahrdaya College of Engineering & Technology and Jawaharlal College of Engineering and Technology for a period of 10 years from 2024-2025 to 2033-2034 as per clause 7.4 and 7.5 of the UGC (Conferment of Autonomous Status Upon Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Autonomous Colleges) Regulations, 2023 respectively.

The Principal Secretary to Government, Higher Education Department, Govt. of Kerala vide papers read (5) to (8) above, has instructed the University to issue necessary notification / order regarding the grant of Autonomous status to Vimal Jyothi Engineering College, St. Joseph's College of Engineering and Technology, Palai, Sahrdaya College of Engineering & Technology and Jawaharlal College of Engineering and Technology as per UGC (Conferment of

Autonomous Status Upon Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Autonomous Colleges) Regulations, 2023 for Autonomous colleges.

The Clause 4 of the UGC (Conferment of Autonomous Status Upon Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Autonomous Colleges) Regulations, 2023, requires the parent University to issue a notification regarding the conferment of autonomous status to colleges which have been granted autonomous status by the UGC.

As per Section 25, sub section 2 (vi) and (vii) of Chapter IV of the APJ Abdul Kalam Technological University Act, 2015 (hereinafter referred to as the "Act"), empowers the Board of Governors to affiliate to itself institutions as constituent colleges or autonomous colleges or regular colleges or colleges with academic autonomy in accordance with the provisions of this Act and the Statutes, Ordinances and Regulations and to withdraw affiliation of colleges and to confer academic autonomy to a college, department of a college or department of University or Centres in accordance with the Statutes.

As per Section 34 sub section (viii) of Chapter IV of the Act, the Academic Council has the powers, duty, and function to "recommend to the Board of Governors, conferment of autonomous status on University Institutions, departments, affiliated colleges, and institutions by the provisions of the Ordinances and policies of the State Government in this regard." Due to exigency the matter of Conferment of Autonomous of the above four colleges were placed before the Syndicate. As per Section 8 (iv) and (v) of Chapter II of the Act, empowers the University to affiliate to itself institutions as constituent colleges or autonomous colleges or regular colleges or colleges with academic autonomy in accordance with the provisions of the Act and the Statutes, Ordinances and Regulations and to withdraw affiliation of colleges obtained in violation of Statutes of the University and to confer academic autonomy to affiliated colleges, institutions or a department of the affiliated colleges or institutions or a department maintained by the University;.

Having considered the provisions of the Act and the Statutes, Ordinances and Regulations, the resolution of the Syndicate referred (9) above, resolved to approve the recommendations of the Syndicate Standing Committee on affiliation held on 23.08.2024 as follows.

1. To issue Order and Notification conferring autonomous status to the following four colleges.

The autonomous colleges shall pay the institution portal fee (Student Data Management and Portal Maintenance / Service charges) as prescribed by the University.

An agreement shall be executed by the autonomous colleges with the University as per the norms approved by the University.

The institution portal fee (Student Data Management and Portal Maintenance / Service charges) dues with the colleges already notified as autonomous by the University to be collected at the earliest through additional fee collection link provided by the University.

Sanction is hereby accorded to implement the resolution of the Syndicate on the above, subject to the provisions in the Act, the Statutes, Regulations and Ordinances issued thereunder and the orders, circulars, guidelines, etc., issued by the University from time to time in this regard and further subject to the provisions in the University Grants Commission (Conferment of Autonomous Status Upon Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Autonomous Colleges) 2023 as amended from time to time.

Sanction is also accorded to confer autonomous status to Vimal Jyothi Engineering College, St. Joseph's College of Engineering and Technology, Palai, Sahrdaya College of Engineering & Technology and Jawaharlal College of Engineering and Technology.

Orders are issued accordingly.
